REQUIRED MATERIALS

- Current official college transcript
- One letter of recommendation (instructor, advisor, or community leader)
- Typed essay (2–5 pages, double-spaced, responding to one approved topic)
 - Describe the personal qualities you have become skilled at during your last college semester that will help you accomplish your academic and occupational goals. Cite an example.
 - How do you see the role of “ETHICS” in ONE of these topics:
 - Science/ Technology
 - American Politics
 - Global Politics
 - The Environment
 - The Law
 - Cite a newsworthy occurrence portrayed in the U.S. media in the last six months and present a pro and con argument on its merits.

We request you provide fresh ideas and not offer the same essay basis utilized in your last application submitted.
